Congress has recently approved a law that offers substantial increases in tax benefits to landowners who donate conservation or agricultural easements before 2008.

The Federal government has recently approved a tremendous expansion of the federal tax incentive for conservation easement donations!

The new law:

- •Raises the deduction a landowner can take for donating a conservation easement from 30% of their income in any year to 50%;
- •Allows qualifying farmers and ranchers to deduct up to 100% of their income; and
- •Increases the number of years over which a donor can take those deductions from 6 years to 16 years.

Please note this law only applies to easements donated in 2006 and 2007!
