Dear Friends and Colleagues,

Western Cuyahoga Audubon Society's Ultra-Walk scheduled for May 24, 2008 is a cause worthy of your support. The East Branch Rocky River Watershed has been designated an Important Bird Area (IBA) by Audubon Ohio. To support ongoing scientific surveys in our Rocky River IBA, WCAS is conducting a 31-mile Ultra-Walk along the Rocky River on the west side of Cleveland on Saturday, May 24. Tom Romito and Stan Searles are walking. Others will participate in a Biathlon (15-mile bike and five-mile run) and Mini Ultra-Walk (five miles). The IBA surveys will document how land use decisions affect bird populations in the Rocky River IBA and surrounding land. The 2006 and 2007 Rocky River IBA breeding bird surveys documented 76 species of breeding birds. Many more are seen in the Rocky River Valley as migrants and visitors.
